

How to calculate your JASSO GPA

- (1) Use "Pattern 5" in Home Institution Grading System

In the Patter 5, A and B are counted as 3, C as 2, D as 1 and F as 0

Note: If you have "S (satisfactory) in your fall 2014 transcript, use Pattern 4.

If you think this spring semester's GPA would be better than the fall semester's, you can replace it later. Submit the latest one when it is available.

- (2) Look at the following SAMPLE Fall 2014 transcript (6 courses (17 credit hours in total)).

(1) How many credit hours of A and B together --→ 11 credit hours.

(2) How many credit hours of C -----→ 4 credit hours.

(3) How many credit hours of D -----→ 1 credit hour.

(4) How many credit hours of F -----→ 1 credit hour

Pill the numbers in the formula below

$$\frac{(11) \times 3 + (4) \times 2 + (1) \times 1 + (0) \times 1}{17} = 2.47 \leftarrow \text{This is your JASSO GPA}$$
