(By the 20th of each month) [At the end of program]: You will be requested to write and submit a report(s) related to your study in Japan. (The type of report(s) varies depending on the type of scholarship) ※It is not possible to guarantee that those who extend the length of their program will also be able to extend their receipt of scholarship funds.</p>
